Contract Title: Land Preparation, Supply and Installation of Irrigation Equipment for small holder growers in the sugar cane producing areas of the northeast and southeast Lowveld in the Kingdom of Swaziland - Round 3 Publication Reference: EuropeAid /130-054/L/WKS/SZ

The European Union, on behalf of and for the account of the Government of the Kingdom of Swaziland, intends to award a works contract for the development of 296.9 ha of infield irrigation for six farmers associations in the KDDP and LUSIP schemes in the Lubombo region of Swaziland. The financial assistance is provided from the DCI / Accompanying Measures for Sugar Protocol Countries programme of the European Union.

The works will include land preparation, and the supply and installation of the irrigation equipment. The contract will include commissioning of the irrigation equipment and training of beneficiaries in its use and maintenance.
